PROGRAM FEATURES

- Assumes student enters with Associate's Degree (A.A.), or equivalent (typically, 18 - 20 transferable courses, with approximately 5 taken for the concentration)
- Complete the Bachelor's Degree in as little as 24 months
- Accelerated further with CLEP, ACE, or by obtaining experiential learning credit
- Approximately 15 - 18 DePaul SNL courses required for degree completion
- Can be completed in an evening or weekend format at DePaul's Loop or 3 suburban locations or completely online
- Financial aid and flexible payment option plans available
- Employer tuition reimbursement accepted

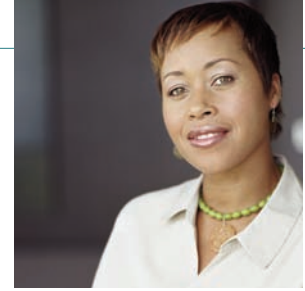
