HOW TO REGISTER: Login to <https://campusconnect.depaul.edu/> – then go to Add/drop a class in the Student Center. Enter the five digit number for each competence you wish to register. **You can register for two competencies in most SNL courses.** By University policy, all registrations incur the DePaul Athletic Fee.

Ready for Advanced Project? There are 2 options to satisfy F11 and F12: FA 303 Independent Advanced Project and FA 304 Advanced Project Course. If you intend to take FA 304, you should have the majority of your focus area competencies completed, or Academic Committee approval that verifies such completion is forthcoming. If you prefer to take Advanced Project as an independent study with your mentor, register for FA 303 and contact your mentor.

Descriptions of New Courses

Loop Campus

AI 108 – International Relations: Weapons, Wars and World in Turmoil – (Truman Bridge/Mon). LATE START

Truman Bridge course. Meets at Truman College 9/25, 10/2 from 5:45pm - 9:05pm. Meets at Loop Campus, 10/9, 10/16, 10/23, 10/30, 11/6, 11/13, 11/20, 11/27, 12/4, 12/11 from 5:45 pm - 9:05 pm. Faculty: Anghesom Atsbaha (Dennis Skentzis). Can be taken for up to 3 competences.

LL 261 – Essay Writing – (Tues)

In this course, students develop their ability to use writing to explore ideas as well as to communicate what they have learned in a variety of contexts. The principles and skills students learn are widely applicable and will improve their communication in business and personal settings as well as at school. This course focuses particular attention on writing to excel in a writing-intensive curriculum. Students learn strategies for combining experience with analysis and reflection in essay writing, managing the writing process, and writing persuasively. Particular emphasis is given to the process of revision. Completion of Essay Writing is a prerequisite for Research Writing. (4 quarter hours) Faculty: Kamilah Cummings (cross listed with LL 260 Writing for Competence)

Offcampus

LL 302 - Externship: Mindfulness Meditation Retreat at Starved Rock State Park (Fall, 2017)

This unique hybrid course involves a four-day retreat (Thursday, September 28th through Sunday, October 1st) at the beautiful Starved Rock Lodge and Conference Center in Utica, IL (1.5 hour drive from Chicago). Starved Rock Lodge sits high atop a wooded bluff overlooking the Illinois River in the magnificent Starved Rock State Park. Every student will have a private guest room in the lodge. There is a fee of \$650 for the retreat, in addition to the 4 credit hours of tuition for the L-10 and L-11 competencies. The fee will be charged to your student account. All other pre- and post-retreat learning activities will take place online during the Fall 2017 quarter. See the syllabus for more details. The pre-requisites for the course are completion of L2, L-4, L-5 competencies and instructor's permission. **You must pre-register** for the course by contacting the instructor, Michael Skelley, directly at mskelley@depaul.edu include your student ID#. The course fills quickly. Pre-registrations will begin in May, 2017.

Mindfulness meditation practices are simple, relaxing, yet powerful ways of developing your mind so that you can be more fully and freely engaged in your daily experiences. The approaches to mindfulness meditation that you will learn in this course are related to Buddhist traditions, but also draw from contemporary insights in neuroscience, psychology and philosophy. No prior experience with meditation is necessary for this course.

The course will be offered again in:

-Spring, 2018 (Starved Rock retreat on April 26th – 29th, 2018)

-Fall, 2018 (Starved Rock retreat on September 27th – 30th, 2018)

LL 261 – Essay Writing

In this course, students develop their ability to use writing to explore ideas as well as to communicate what they have learned in a variety of contexts. The principles and skills students learn are widely applicable and will improve their communication in business and personal settings as well as at school. This course focuses particular attention on writing to excel in a writing-intensive curriculum. Students learn strategies for combining experience with analysis and reflection in essay writing, managing the writing process, and writing persuasively. Particular emphasis is given to the process of revision. Completion of Essay Writing is a prerequisite for Research Writing. (4 quarter hours) Faculty: Steffanie Triller and Nicholas Hayes (cross listed with LL 260 Writing for Competence)
